<u>Communication with your teacher:</u> Feel free to email or send a note to school with any questions regarding your child. My email address is: wayka foxborough.k12.ma.us. It is difficult to return phone calls and emails during the school day while I am teaching so I will respond to your inquiry as quickly as I can, usually by that evening. Transportation changes: If your child is going home a different way or if you are picking your child up from school early, he or she <u>must bring a note</u>. You may also email the secretary, Mrs. McLaughlin, at the main office and she will let me know of any changes. If you send an email about a change that needs to happen that day I may not see it prior to dismissal time. Thank you for your understanding with this.

<u>Snack & Water Bottles:</u> Both morning and afternoon students will have a quick snack (approx. 5-7 min). It is also our mask break. <u>ALL SNACKS ARE PEANUT FREE... this is schoolwide.</u> And FYI, water bottles will be brought home <u>EVERY DAY</u> for cleaning with water & soap. Thank you!

<u>Remote work</u>: I provided your child with a red folder that should be used for remote work only. The remote work these first two weeks back will be review activities for ELA and math.

<u>Birthdays</u>: Birthdays will be celebrated on or around your child's birthday. As per Foxborough Public School policy due to food allergies, we ask that you **please do not send in food of any kind for birthdays**. If your child has a summer birthday, we will celebrate it towards the end of the school year. ©

Toys, Games, Electronics: Please be advised that all toys, stuffed animals, games, trading cards, electronic equipment (Ipods, I touch), and cell phones should NOT be brought to school. Please refer to the student handbook for specifics. Please have your child keep all of his/her personal items at home where they are safe. Thank you for your cooperation.
